




### 1 Precautions for Use

Always make sure that sleeves and other parts of clothing are inside the protective frame.

Never hang items from the protective frame. Doing so could damage the clothing or product and result in product failure. Always rotate the rack slowly after gripping it firmly by the protective frame.






# 2 Disassembly instructions


■ Removing the clothes rails

Loosen the clothes rail fixing screw, then remove the clothes rail. After removing it, place the decorative cap over the hole.



■ Removing the protective frame

Loosen the protective frame fixing screw and nut, then remove the protective frame. Once you have removed the protective frame, place the decorativecap over the hole.



# 3 Cleaning and Care

 When cleaning the unit, wipe with a sponge soaked in diluted dishwashing detergent.

(Avoid using alkaline cleaners or acidic cleaners.)
