The use of LIONGRIP X-TRA could be contributing LEED credits from the Canadian Green Building Council Rating System for New Construction & Major Renovations as follow:

IEQc3.2: CONSTRUCTION IAQ MANAGEMENT PLAN - TESTING BEFORE OCCUPANCY

Low VOC content of LIONGRIP X-TRA can contribute to air quality test.

IEQc4.1: LOW-EMITTING MATERIALS - ADHESIVES & SEALANTS

LIONGRIP X-TRA content of VOC is less than 30 g/L less water meeting the requirement of South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Rule No.1168. LIONGRIP X-TRA do not contain VOC in excess of 5% by weight.

IEQc4.4: LOW-EMITTING MATERIALS - COMPOSITE WOOD AND LAMINATE ADHESIVES

LIONGRIP X-TRA contains no urea-formaldehyde resin added and can be used in the composition of assemblies produced on site and in the workshop.

IEQc4.5: LOW-EMITTING MATERIALS - FURNITURE AND FURNISHINGS

LIONGRIP X-TRA contains no urea-formaldehyde resin added and can be used in the composition of assemblies produced on site and in the workshop.

MRc2: CONSTRUCTION WASTE MANAGEMENT

Packaging of LIONGRIP X-TRA is made of recoverable and recyclable materials and can be collected for treatment where facilities exist.
