

Door Preparation

It is recommended to pre-drill all screws. For bypassing doors mount parallel tracks.

These instructions assume a properly framed opening with a carefully leveled header

For use only in framed installations, do not use in an open ended application


For bi-parting doors use an additional set of hardware.

For single door, cut a groove in the door bottom (for the floor guide) per Figure 1

Mount top plates to the top of the door(s) right). using #10 x 1"[25.4] flat head screws, as shown in Figure 1 (and illustration to the

The opening in the top plate MUST face opposite directions,

towards the edge of the door.




N Track

Insert carriers into the track

Mount track using #10 x 1"[25.4] pan head screws (every other mounting hole)

For by-pass application, space tracks per Figure 1 for door thickness



3 Floor Guide


For single / bi-parting door

Align floor guide vertically with the center of the track and fasten with $(4) \#6 \times 3/4$ " [19.1] screws.



For bypassing doors

Align floor guide center piece vertically with the center of the track and mount with #8 x 3/4[19.1] screws.



Mounting Door(s)

- Bring carriers into position
- Rotate the latch lock into the open position and insert the adjustment nut into the opening of the top plate
- Height adjustment is performed by turning the adjustment nut with a 9/16" wrench

(Latch lock must be in open position for adjustment)
Important: Lock the adjustment nut into the top plate
via the latch lock



Adjust door vertically to confirm clearance dimension from floor to bottom of door (7/16" for single / bi-parting, 3/8" for bypassing). See figure 1 on page 1.
